



McCollister's Adopts 5S



5S Method



The 5S Philosophy was developed in Japan and stands for the Japanese words seiri (tidiness), seiton (orderliness), seiso (cleanliness), seiketsu (standardization), and shitsuke (discipline). These words have been adopted into the English words; Sort, Set In Order, Shine, Standardize and Sustain, making up the Americanized version of the 5S Philosophy

SAFETY
